Why choose to study Creative and Media Diploma Level 3?

You will learn the processes and specialised knowledge that are common to all creative industries while you develop your English, Maths and ICT skills. Subject Specific Entrance Requirements

Creative and Media Diploma Level 2 or the equivalent of GCSE grade B in Arts subject and ICT.

Resources and Facilities

The Creative and Media Suite in the Academy is equipped with digital SLR cameras, digital and video cameras, mac PCs and laptops and a radio station. Professionals from industry complete placements and workshops with students and outside agencies and companies provide additional support and facilities.

This course has a minimum requirement of 10 days' Work Experience. This will give you the chance to develop and apply the skills you have learned in the classroom. You will also get the chance to learn and be mentored by professionals working in their chosen field.

Teaching and Learning Styles

You will cover a range of subjects from film, animation, photography, fashion design, radio, art, music technology and drama including creative writing and journalism.

Work is assessed throughout the course. Students are encouraged to work independently to develop the skills needed within the industry. There are many opportunities to work with professionals and build links with creative and media industries.

Progression Opportunities

Progression from this course is onto a degree, similar higher education or onto one of the training programmes run by the BBC and other employers.
