
Parent or carer is ill, family related problems, behavioural issues, profound additional needs.

Services for adults or children with specific needs

- Why might adults or children with specific needs, need care?
- What services help them?

Domiciliary

Trained care workers visit and support the person in their own home.



Residential

The person lives in the setting where 24-hour care is available from trained care staff

Respite care

This service provides temporary care to give carers a break.

It may be extra care at home or temporary care in a residential home.

Learning disabilities

Mild disabilities can live successfully alone
Complex disabilities need intense 24 hour
care



Sensory impairments

A problem that affects the senses
for example vision or hearing

Specific needs



Long-term health issues

Could be born with conditions such as cerebral palsy or asthma
Others develop disorders such as dementia.
