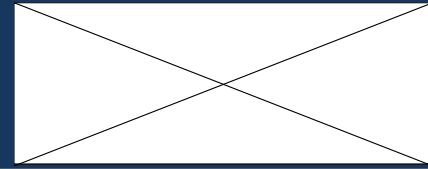
## GREAT BRITISH BAKE OFF

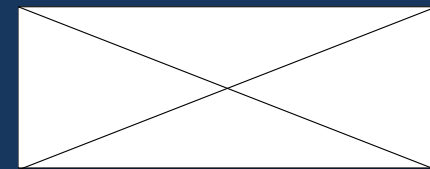

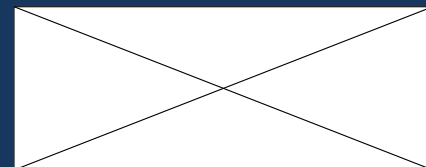

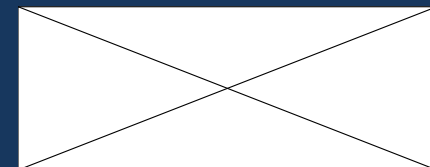

## Design Brief - Analyse

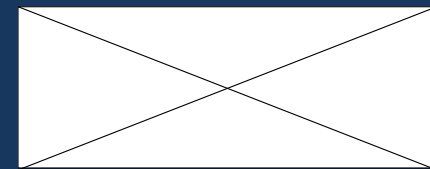
