Dear Parent/Carer

I hope this letter finds you safe and well. I am writing to provide more detailed information regarding the options process for Year 9 students and to reassure both our students and parents/carers that your options are as much a priority as they would be if schools were open.

On Monday, Mr Collins led a Teams assembly for Year 9 students explaining the process and the importance of carefully considering the subjects students will choose to study for their GCSEs in Years 10 and 11.

During this assembly Mr Collins explained the process and how vital it is to choose a subject for the right reasons and not, for example, because friends have opted for a subject.

In addition to the compulsory Core Subjects (English, Maths and Science), students will make choices from the table below. It is important that students choose carefully as the subjects opted will be studied until the end of Year 11 and should of course be considered alongside potential career pathways/post-16 pathways.
