Welcome letter to parents and carers for the new academic year 2019-20

We are excited about welcoming our largest ever year 7 cohort into the academy community and delighted to be oversubscribed in this year group as our reputation has grown in local community as the secondary school of choice.

GCSE Examination Results 2019

The Class of 2019 had much to celebrate this summer as the academy continues to be one of the highest performing schools in Salford for pupil progress. Despite the more challenging nature of the new exams, I am pleased to report that our students performed well with over half of the cohort achieving a grade 4 pass in both English and maths. Attainment was particularly good in a number of subjects including vocational qualifications with many students achieving the highest grades available in this area.

We are also delighted that a number of students achieved the coveted grade 9 in a range of subjects, including Science, Product Design and languages. We are so proud of all our students who have achieved the qualifications they need to progress to further education, training or apprenticeships and ultimately a fulfilling career. I am enormously grateful to our dedicated and talented staff team for supporting and enabling our students to achieve so much.

Students will return to the academy on Wednesday 4th September. We have arranged a staggered start to ensure that our new year 7 students have the time they need for induction at the start of the day. Students will return to school as follows:

- 8.30am Year 7
- 9.40am Year 8 and 9

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Uniform

All students are expected to return to the academy in full uniform. Uniform must be worn according to the academy uniform policy, but can I remind parents and carers of the following:

- Black blazer with academy badge is compulsory and must be worn at all times
- Black tailored trousers or black **pleated skirt** must be worn, skinny trousers and tight fitting skirts are not permitted
- Black flat-heeled shoes (no boots)
- Facial piercings, including tongue piercings, are forbidden.
- False/acrylic and painted nails are not permitted
- Only natural hair colours are acceptable, no tramlines or extreme hairstyles will be permitted. Headbands and bobbles should be black.
