RE: FREE EXTRA TUTORING FOR YOUR CHILD

This school is committed to helping every single one of our pupils to fulfil their potential and to do the best they can in their studies. As part of this commitment, we are pleased to be partnering with a local education charity, Tutor Trust. Your child has been chosen to have the benefit of high-quality, personalised additional support from one of their tutors. This programme is part of the national effort to support schools in addressing the impact of Covid-19 school closures on pupils. The National Tutoring Programme aims to enable pupils to access a future they deserve by re-engaging them and rebuilding their confidence, delivered by a subject expert.

Tutor Trust is an award-winning charity with a strong track record of partnering successfully with schools. Currently, Tutor Trust is a delivery partner of the Government's National Tutoring Programme. This means the school can access tutoring at very low cost (please note, there will be no charge at all parents/carers).

The charity's tutors are, in the main, bright, talented students at local universities and, as such, they act as great role models too. They will support pupils to achieve, building on the excellent work that our classroom teachers do. You can read more about Tutor Trust at www.TheTutorTrust.org*. All the tutors have, of course, an enhanced DBS check.

The chance to have a 'private tutor' is a great opportunity for your child to thrive academically and to grow in confidence. Your child will receive curriculum-focused tuition from a fully qualified maths tutor. Pupils involved will work with their tutor in small groups with two other pupils and cover three modules across 15 hours of tuition. This tuition will take place in school time and is coordinated all in the school day. This does mean, in the short term your child will miss other timetabled lessons, however, we firmly believe that there is an overall benefit, and this is well worth doing. Tutoring is due to commence on Tuesday 6th December and will run for 7.5 weeks (tutoring will not take place during assessment weeks). Some students will start their tutoring next week, others students will not start their tutoring until later on in the academic year.

Your child has been chosen very carefully as someone we feel will benefit from this tutoring. It is important to realise that this is a very valuable resource and only a small number of students will be able to access this tutoring. Therefore, we are asking for a commitment
