Please see below my weekly update

We have been very impressed as the weeks continue by the return to school and the way that our students have adapted to the new structures and systems. Curriculum overview

Due to the impact of Covid-19 over teachers have worked incredibly hard to ensure a recovery curriculum is in place, all units of work have been reviewed and where needed adapted to ensure students receive their full entitlement. In order to keep parents updated I have asked Mr McEvoy (Deputy Principal Curriculum) to write to you all with detailed curriculum plans and overviews. The information we share will also be placed on the school website for you to view and discuss with your child what they have been/will be learning.

Covid update:

I trust that you have found the information we have sent since the start of the year of use and you are clear as parents/carers what to do if your child or a member of your household should show symptoms.

Whilst we have had to send bubbles home to isolate I wanted to reassure you all that we have robust risk assessments in place in line with direct advice from the Department for Education and the health and safety of all students and staff remains my number one priority.

Please can I remind parents however that if your child has one of the three main symptoms or any member of your household is awaiting a test result you must not send your child into school.
