Dear Parents/Carers,

As we settle into the new academic year, I am writing to you today, to update you on our homework policy. We have reflected on our policy last year and we are now re-launching our homework policy for the year ahead, and we would ask that you support the school to ensure your child completes and hands their homework in using the correct platform, on the correct day.

The purpose of homework is to build upon classroom learning and embed key knowledge through recall. It gives pupils the opportunity to research topics further and in more depth, and it teaches them to work towards and meet deadlines.

Homework will be accessed in several different ways, mainly through Microsoft TEAMS/FORMS but also through online platforms SPARX/EDUCAKE, or by completing handouts and taking books home to complete class work.

Pupils will be expected to complete their homework for the following week. If they do forget they will have one fail opportunity to complete the homework before an Action is sanctioned. Pupils will receive 5 achievement points per subject once their homework has been handed in and logged by their teacher.
