Dear parent/carer

I am writing to inform you of the Y11 rewards strategy linked to their attendance to sessions and behaviour.

Your child will receive a passport to prom where they will get it marked each week by their pastoral leader for their attendance. Each half term there will then be a reward. Half term 1 – Pizza for lunch, Half term 2 – Cinema Trip, Half term 3 – Ice cream, and Half term 4 – Prom. Teachers will also be able to log passport to prom points during revision sessions on Class Charts increasing their positive point count allowing them to be entered into a prize draw before prom winning things such as gift vouchers, prom tickets, and accessories.

If they lose their passport that is fine, we have systems in place to ensure they don't miss out! I would hope this encourages your child to attend school, attend revision sessions, and study hard for their GCSE exams. We have also started to hand out pastoral postcards during Period 5 every day to prove to students their hard work is being noticed and dedication does not go unmissed.

To add to this a week before the end of each half term students will be able to spend their points on our Class Charts shop. Things they can spend their points on include Alexa's, Airpods, gift cards for PS/Xbox, snacks, and stationary. Once the points have been spent, they will have to earn more points to spend.
