

Dear Parent / Carer,

We are hoping to organise an end of year celebration trip to Blackpool for the whole school as a reward for all their hard work this year and good attendance. For the trip to go ahead, we need an indication of how many students would like to attend. This cost covers coach travel, insurance, and entrance to the Pleasure Beach. We aim to have some fund-raising events planned to help subsidize other costs of the trip.

We think that this is a fantastic opportunity for your child to celebrate all their hard work and enjoy a fun day out, the proposed dates for the trips are stated below.

- 6th May 2022 - Year 11
- 20th July 2022 - Year's 7 and 9
- 21st July 2022 - Years 8 and 10

The total cost of the trip is £20 and its to be paid in cash by 31st March. Please ensure the cash is safely deposited in an envelope with your child's name and year on and it is handed to your pastoral leader.

During the rewards assembly last term, students were informed that for them to be able to attend:

- Year's 7 -10 must have +96% Attendance from January 5th 2022 until July 15th 2022
- Year 11 must have +96% Attendance from January 2022 until April 25th 2022
- Year's 7-10 no more than 50 actions from January 2022 until July 15th 2022
- Year 11 no more than 30 actions from January 2022 until April 25th 2022

Due to year 11 leaving for college before the above date we aim to take them in May 2022 after their Mock Exams and before their GCSE's.

Any absence due to Covid illness will not affect the child's place to attend. Students may miss the trip due to absence for holidays, days off for birthday celebrations, inconsistent levels attendance throughout the next few weeks may result in students not being allowed to attend.

Behaviour around the academy is also important students must be following the Mediacity Way. Unfortunately, if students are not following the 'Mediacity Way' this could result in them receiving 'Actions' for poor behaviour or serious incidents which could prevent students from attending the trip. All students have been informed about the terms of the trip.

Further information regarding the trip's logistics will be sent out later during the academic year.
