Dear Parent/Carer,

Throughout the year your child will learn how to make a variety of different food products and develop a wide range of cooking skills that will equip them for life. To allow this work to happen successfully, we provide ingredients for students to complete their practical tasks. Purchasing the ingredients from school works out cheaper, as we buy in bulk and only charge for what the student will use, and this means that the student can always successfully complete the requirements of the course.

The costs can be paid via the MCAS app.

Please see break down per year group/class

- Students in KS4
 - (Years 11) will be required to pay £20 for the whole year – All ingredients are bought for the practical exam for your child.
 - (Years 10) will be required to pay £30 for the whole year.
- Students in KS3 (y7, 8 +9) are on a rotation so only have food for half of the year. They are required to pay £20 for the whole year.

In addition to these contributions we will now be expecting your child to bring a container to take their food home that they have made during lessons. We will no longer be providing packaging as we have previously done. This packaging needs to be clearly labelled with your child's name and class. They must remember to bring this in for their practical lessons.

Here are some examples of suitable containers at a reasonable price but any of similar size (2-3 Litre capacity) would also be suitable. Please do not give your child a glass container or tin.
