Partial Academy closure

As many of you will know, the government has announced a new national lockdown to stop the spread of the coronavirus. You can read more information about the national lockdown on the [gov.uk website](https://www.gov.uk) or by searching 'gov.uk national lockdown'.

The Academy remains open for the children of critical workers or those who are determined as 'vulnerable' who must attend the Academy.

Children of critical workers:

Please see the attached, updated document on whether your child is eligible to come to school. If you believe, your child meets the criteria for this category and you have not already done so please contact us at info@oasismediacityuk.org and a member of staff will contact you as soon as possible. Please note places are limited but we will do our best to accommodate all requests.

All other students:

All other students are being asked to learn remotely until February half term. As per my previous emails our remote learning plan is in place and will continue for all year groups. Please see further information below from Mr McEvoy regarding remote learning, he will also update parents/carers on a regular basis through letters and video messages.

- Your child will be required to access their learning remotely.
- All learning will take place via Microsoft Teams, we deliver five live lessons each day and follow the normal school timetable.
- Lessons start at 8.40 and finish at 2.30 with a break and lunch during the day.
- To access our live online lessons your child will need access to the internet and a laptop, computer or tablet.
- If your child will have any difficulty in accessing remote learning, please be in touch with us directly either by accessing the help section of the school website, e-mailing the pastoral leader or calling the academy phone line.

The staff team will continue to work hard to ensure that all students, either in the Academy or learning from home, will have access to high quality teaching and learning.

Year 11 GCSE examinations

The Prime Minister announced that the schedule of public examinations for the summer term will not go ahead in the current format. The organisation that oversees national examinations, Ofqual, will be releasing more information in due course about how results will be determined.
