These are a fantastic range of activities which help prepare students in Greater Manchester to think about their future and are delivered by Greater Manchester universities and higher education providers. They are fully funded by Greater Manchester Higher so are of no cost to you nor the school.

Pupils take part in a variety of interactive activities and workshops, allowing them to:

- Get an insight into higher education.
- Meet other like-minded students from Greater Manchester.
- Develop their skills and boost their confidence.
- Learn about different industries and related careers
- Get crucial advice on making decisions for after school and beyond.

There's something for everyone – some Uni:4U events deep dive into specific subjects and others give a broad overview of higher education and student life.

Your young person will need to complete an online application form to express their interest in one of the summer schools and as part of that application, parent/carer contact details need to be included. We usually receive more applications than places, so please ensure everything is completed as fully as possible and that your young person is committed to attending.
