Dear Parents and Carers,

It has sadly come to that time of year when we have to say goodbye to our year 11 students, they have truly been an amazing year group and I have been particularly impressed with how well they have coped with the difficulties the pandemic has brought which has been challenging for us all. As you are aware things have been very different this year due to Covid 19 and so I wanted to write to you to confirm the plan for your child over the coming weeks.

Week commencing 24<sup>th</sup> May all students are expected in school as per their usual timetable, it is vital that all students attend as some students may be required to sit assessments to support with the grading process as directed by the Department for Education. On Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May we will hold a Leavers Assembly and celebration of your child's time with us, lunch will also be provided. The students will leave the Academy at 12pm to enable the rest of the school to continue their day without further disruption.

For weeks commencing 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> June (the week commencing Monday 31<sup>st</sup> May is half-term week) we will be providing work on TEAMS around preparing them for life after school and our local colleges and sixth form providers have been very helpful in providing this work. We will also be providing work from the Oak National Academy so that if they wish, they can access any lessons that they feel may be beneficial to help them once they have left school. More details will follow about this next week from Mr McEvoy.

It is important to note that students must be available during both weeks commencing 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> June as they may be called back into school with specified appointments to complete specific work/NEET-prevention/careers interviews with their teachers.

We are also very much looking forward to our Prom (Covid restrictions permitting) at Hotel Football on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> of July 2021. A separate letter about this will follow from Mr McGrattan.

GCSE results day is Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August and students can pick their results between 10:00am – 11.30am. Students are only able to collect their own results and cannot pick them up for anyone else. If you know that you are going to be away on that date then please contact the Academy before the summer holidays to make other arrangements. We will be sending further communication out about this day nearer the time.

I would like to finish by thank you all for your support during your child's time with us and wish you all a safe and happy summer.
