Dear Year 11 Parents/Carers,

**Re: Year 11 Detention and Intervention Plan**

I hope this letter finds you well. As we approach the final stretch of your child's time in Year 11, it is more important than ever to ensure that all students remain focused and are making the most of the support available to them. To achieve this, we are introducing a new Detention and Intervention Plan starting from **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025**, to provide greater consistency and accountability for all Year 11 students.

**The Detention Plan**

If a Year 11 student is logged for a subject reset, they will be required to attend a detention in **H&W 1** under my supervision. This session will not only address the reasons for the reset but will also ensure students are directed toward their required intervention sessions to support their learning.

**Key Details of the Plan:**

**1. Attendance Procedure:**

- Students will report to me at the start of their detention session.
- To ensure attendance and focus, students will be asked to hand over items such as phones, money, or other personal belongings upon arrival. These items will be securely stored and delivered to their intervention room following the detention.

**2. Intervention Attendance:**

- After the detention, students will proceed directly to their assigned intervention room to complete focused work.
- Any student who attends their detention but fails to attend their intervention session will face an escalation to an **ALT Detention**.

**3. Non-Attendance:**

- Students who do not attend their detention without a valid reason will also face escalated consequences, ensuring that all students understand the importance of adhering to this plan.

**Rationale:**

This plan has been implemented to address inconsistencies in detentions and interventions within Year 11. With exams rapidly approaching, it is vital that we maintain a high standard of discipline and focus for all students to maximize their potential.

We kindly ask for your support in reinforcing the importance of this plan with your child. It is designed not as a punitive measure, but as a way to ensure that every Year 11 student is given the structure and support they need to succeed.
