Dear parents/carers

Firstly, I would like to say how pleased we are with the positive attitude and maturity our year 11 students are showing in their final year at Oasis MediacityUK. Please see below the additional revision sessions being offered afterschool between now and the GCSE exams. Attendance to as many as possible is strongly recommended and will also be linked to rewards throughout the year.

The final mock exams for year 11 will be this half term during the last two weeks (week commencing 6th February and 13th February). This is the final set of pre-public examinations prior to their GCSE's.

It is vital that students perform at their best during these exams so that teachers can have a very clear picture of their strengths and weaknesses and can help the students improve before their actual GCSE's this summer. Teachers will be spending the next four weeks ensuring students are ready for these assessments, so please can you support us by ensuring students are in every day.

Please also be aware that the Department of Education have asked us to keep the results of the February PPE's and the papers secure in the unlikely event GCSE's were cancelled, Grades would be awarded using book work and the February mock exams as evidence.

To support and reward our year 11's who are working exceptionally hard in their studies, we have planned a reward trip to Blackpool. This will run in early in May, shortly before the GCES's begin. In addition to this, at the end of the exams, we have organised a Prom for students to celebrate their achievements at the academy.

Attendance to both events will require students to have good attendance in school, to attend revision/coursework sessions after school and attend all formal exams. Failure to attend a formal exam, without medical evidence, will result in your child not being able to attend Prom.

Finally, as I have said before, we are very proud of this Year 11 and how they are preparing for their PPE's and GCSE's. Thank you for your continued support and encouragement from home. The more revision and preparation they are doing now, the more confident they will feel for the forthcoming exams and ultimately, the better their results will be.
